



**Announcement of School of Medical Science
Policy of not giving and accepting gifts from performance of duties
(No Gift Policy) Fiscal year B.E. 2569 (2026)**

The School of Medical Sciences at Phayao University recognizes the importance of addressing corruption comprehensively, with cooperation from all sectors, to eradicate it completely. This is to foster a culture and values of integrity, ethics, and transparency in our operations, thereby reducing corruption and instilling a sense of morality to promote individuals with ethical values. Therefore, we hereby declare our commitment to implementing a No Gift Policy for the School of Medical Sciences for the fiscal year 2569 B.E., with the aim of strengthening integrity values in the work practices of the School of Medical Sciences according to the principles of moral excellence. This declaration serves as a strong statement of intent to steadfastly oppose all forms of corruption. As the highest administrators of the School of Medical Sciences, we thus declare the following commitment.

1. The executives and personnel of School of Medical Sciences should not give and accept gifts from their performance of duties, both before or after performance of duties which would be conducive to corruption and misconduct on every festival or occasions and do not cooperate and support all forms of corruption.

The executives and personnel of School of Medical Sciences adhere to the ethical standard of Personnel and the Code of Ethics of the University of Phayao and keep the good attitude and consciousness on performance of duty with transparency, impartiality, and verifiability without expecting anything in return and being responsible to the community, society, and country for the value and culture in the organization concretely.
